Some Tips Overlooked in Evangelizing

Sharing the Good News to people has always been the objective of the. Many among us are so concern of the truth that we share and I do not question the idea of sharing the TRUTH. Less or No Hospitality at all

Less or No Sensitivity

When we are not sensitive to their life's problem and are not willing to even offer any help, how can we convince them that we cared for their souls? Many are so impatient and not willing to extend what is necessary to be able to help and make him a brother or sister. 2 John 1:8 says; "Watch yourselves, so that you may not lose what we have worked for, but may win a full reward." Romans 12:15 "Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep." (ESV)

Does not know how to carry on regular conversation.
