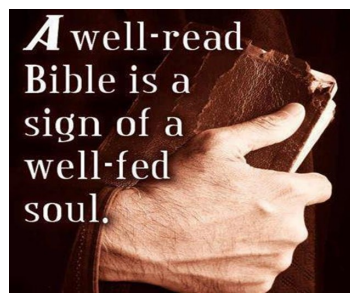

Every time you study the Bible and pay attention to what you're reading, you're learning something. Proverbs 4:20-22 says, "My son attend to my words...for they are life to those who find them..." The word "attend" means to pay attention to, give some time to something. To attend to the Word of God is a lot more than just reading; it's meditating on it.

Today, there is so much confusion concerning salvation. People are confused because one preacher teaches something about salvation, and the other teaches another. Many people do not want to obey the gospel because they are confused. Satan knows that if he can get people to be confused about salvation, this will cause them to be lost. Satan knows that Jesus is the door to salvation ([John 10:9](#)). Therefore, Satan has created many ways of salvation to confuse people. But, people need to know that God is not the author of confusion, but of peace ([1 Corinthians 14:33](#)). Though Man may be confused God says in John 8:32 "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." What people need to do is go back to the Bible and learn what God says about salvation.

Let us always be aware that we are commanded to teach only what God says and not what man says. Apostle Peter said: "If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. We are aware today that many have decided to teach man's doctrine. We have to be afraid of accepting and teaching false doctrine as Paul said in 1 Corinthians 9:16: For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, **woe** is unto me, if I preach not the gospel! Bible's use of the word "woe" is Isaiah 5 in the Old Testament (where it occurs 7 times) and Matthew 23 in the New (where it occurs on the lips of Jesus 8 times). You may discover that the word was used by Isaiah and Jesus in their respective times and places to express God's displeasure and grief over sin and eroding moral and spiritual values. Isaiah warns in Isaiah 5:20, "Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; Who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; Who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!" And Jesus threatens the practitioners of shallow and corrupt religion of His day, "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of extortion and self-indulgence" (Matthew 23:25).

We need to get into agreement with what God wants us to do because, as the writer of Proverbs says, these words are life! When you need an encouraging word, or you're in a negative environment, it's good to know that you can find life in God's Word.

Let's just simply go back brethren to what the Bible says. If you are looking for SALVATION, study, read and search the Bible for in it you will find eternal life!
