

Be Not Caught Unaware: You have the Same Old World

Our world is plagued by different false teachings. The pressure of bringing people back to the truth seems to be “wrong” and the acceptance and practice of false teaching has become popular. For example, immoral acts have evolved unnoticed and the acceptance of immoral acts became strong in the community and now, too hard to be stopped. These are abortion, pre-marital relationships, acceptance of gays/lesbians, issues on marriage-divorce-re-marriage and many others. The church is affected by these problems and therefore, we must be aware of our surroundings. Satan is not sleeping while Christians ‘log off’ of their responsibilities in preaching. Matthew Henry Commentary says; “people will turn away from the truth, they will grow weary of the plain gospel of Christ, they will be greedy of fables, and take pleasure in them. People do so when they will not endure that preaching which is searching, plain, and to the purpose. Those who love souls must be ever watchful, must venture and bear all the painful effects of their faithfulness, and take all opportunities of making known the pure gospel.”

The purity of the Gospel is what we always needed to share. This means it is the “Sound Doctrine” that needs to be preached to every individual. But many no longer love the truth and they changed their priorities toward earthly materials that have no spiritual value. They do not “seek God” (Matthew 6:33). They miss Bible studies or midweek services. They do not socialize with brothers and sisters in Christ even making a habit of forsaking the assembly on Sundays (Hebrews 10:25). Some behavioral problems easily come out – rebelling against “sound preaching” and they seek fake comforts within “unbiblical churches.” Jude:1:18-19 says; *How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.* The call for men to be faithful followers of Christ is a holy call to make men righteous. It is a free gift just for all to have eternal life. Those who faithfully obey the Gospel are not ashamed and will never oppose the “sound doctrine.” But Paul said in First Timothy 1:10(KJV) *“For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine.”* We have to bear in mind that we defeat God’s command when we tend to weaken our love to God, or love to the brethren.

Satan’s goal is to look for victims as 1 Peter 5:8 says; *“Be sober, be vigilant, because your adversary the devil walketh about as a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.”* Worldly men separate from our Lord, and His Church, and would rather join themselves to the devil, the world, and the flesh, by doing ungodly and sinful practices. They do not have the spirit of holiness, and do not belong to Christ. Our Lord wants us to be guided and embrace His teaching for us to escape damnation. If we go back and follow the TRUTH taught in the Bible, we have that great hope of eternal life. Let us go back to the true teaching and hold on to that and avoid being gullible by searching the truth. Ephesians 4:14 says; *“Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming.”* The fact that we hold on to the truth, we will always stay at His will and will never be lost.
