Why Should We be Afraid of Hell?

If many are afraid of death, HELL is a reality that should shake and terrify us. The only source of truth about Hell is found in the Bible. Opinions and comments made opposite from the description offered by the Holy Scriptures is questionable and false. Some people define "hell" as the sufferings and trouble they experience here on earth. When life is not working well, they call it hell.

Hell is a place prepared for the wicked. There will be no escape there and God will render His wrath upon those who are ungodly and wicked, who suppressed the truth because of their disobedience (Romans 1:18). Other passages from the scripture say that when the disobedient have been resurrected, fire comes down out of heaven and destroys the wicked and Satan (Revelation 20:7-9). Therefore, the fires of hell will burn across the entire face of the earth, allowing no escape for the wicked. The scriptures say; "But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up" 2 Peter 3:10

In the Old Testament, fire cleanses and brings complete eradication of sin! Nahum 1:9 says "Whatever they plot against the LORD He will bring to an end; trouble will not come a second time." Sin and trouble will not ever rise the second time around. With the Devil and all his wickedness burned up, sin and affliction will never rise again. Hell has always been described as fire that is burning. Revelation 21:10 says; "But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars--they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death." The agonies and terrors of the first death will lead to the far greater terrors and agonies of eternal death (Matthew Henry Commentary). Eternal death is the eternal fire that cannot be quenched (Mark 9:48). This is the eternal torment described as an unending agony in hell.

While we live in the love and mercy of God now, as He dearly wants us to be saved by telling us through His son Jesus, yet if we disobey and deliberately reject Him, In His time, the disobedient will meet God's wrath. This wrath is the second death - it is the eternal punishment. Matthew 13:50 describes it as furnace when it says; "and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." The evil has a prepared place for them for being disobedient. "These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life" (Matthew 25:46). And these shall go away into everlasting punishment - No appeal, no remedy, to all eternity! No end to the punishment of those whose final impenitence manifests in them an eternal will and desire to sin. By dying in a settled opposition to God, they cast themselves into a necessity of continuing in an eternal aversion from him (Clarkes' Commentary).

Why should we be afraid of hell? God is not joking! He has eternal reward to the obedient and eternal punishment to those who ignored His call.
